

Nashville's Hop On/Off trolley tour stops at **seven of the city's major attractions**, and is narrated by driver/guides. Board your trolley at the Hard Rock Café and stay on for the full one-hour tour, or hop off to explore the sights.

In addition to the Historic District of downtown Nashville, Hop On/Off points include the Ryman Auditorium, Bicentennial Capitol Mall State Park, Antique Archaeology – the retail shop of TV show American Pickers' Mike Wolfe, the Parthenon, the Frist Center for the Visual Arts, and the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum.

Take a journey back in time as you visit two of the most historic mansions in the Southeast – The Hermitage and Belle Meade Plantation.

Ride in comfort to **The Hermitage**, the home of President

Andrew Jackson. Preservationists continue to use a number of scientific techniques to preserve, restore and repair the mansion and other buildings on this 1,050-acre cotton plantation. Historians consider this the best-preserved early U.S. presidential home, and it is ready for you to explore just as it would have been in 1836.

Next, on rolling land that, in the 1800's, made up an estate of more than 2,500 acres in size, you will find **Belle Meade Plantation**. Once a world-renowned thoroughbred farm, the

mansion is a beautiful

example of Greek-Revival



Antebellum architecture. Enjoy a narrated tour through the mansion by a guide in period clothing, and explore other buildings on the grounds, on your own. Complete the tour and the day with a wine tasting at The Winery at Belle Meade. Lunch is on your own at Hermitage House Smorgasbord. A full Southern-style buffet, including dessert, beverage and tax. FRANKLIN'S CIVIL WAR: A LEGACY OF HEROES
