# Sibiu City Break

Go back in time to medieval Europe and explore the unique idyllic charm



Sibiu is one of the most important and beautiful cultural centres in Romania and it was the European Capital of Culture in 2007, together with Luxembourg, being the first city in South-Eastern Europe to receive this title. The city has the power to fascinate and take you back in time and it was ranked Europe's 8th most idyllic place to live by Forbes magazine.

Sibiu (Hermannstadt in German) was the largest and wealthiest of the seven walled citadels built in the 12th century by German settlers known as Transylvanian Saxons. Sibiu's Old Town retains the grandeur of its earlier days when rich and powerful guilds dominated regional trade. Sections of the medieval wall still guard the historic area, where narrow streets pass steep-roofed 17th century buildings and church-dominated squares such as Great Square and Little Square.

Sibiu is a pedestrian-friendly city with two easily accessible levels: the Upper town, home to most of Sibiu's historic sights, and the Lower town, lined with colorful houses on cobblestone streets and bounded by imposing city walls and defense towers overlooking the river Cibin. For hundreds of years, this walled town in the heart of Transylvania was one of the most powerful and prosperous strongholds in Europe.

Although the entire network is remarkably well-preserved, three 15th century towers have withstood the test of time: Harquebusiers' Tower, Carpenters' Tower and Potters' Tower and currently Sibiu's Old Center is in the process of becoming part of the UNESCO World Heritage sites.
